While your experience in HCAI is affected by your licence status, The licence itself is governed by FSRA, which has resources available to understand the application and renewal process. This includes managing your licence, renewal procedures, and surrendering your licence.

Updating your licence after a business change

When your organization undergoes a change in ownership, merger, or other large business infrastructure change, review <u>FSRA's Resources</u> for advice and to decide what changes, if any, need to be made to your Licence.
